CHARTER RESOLUTION

REVISED AND RESTATED JULY, 1989

WHEREAS, the undersigned governmental units of the State of North Carolina, together with the other county and municipal governmental units in North Carolina or a state adjoining North Carolina hereafter adopting concurrent Resolutions identical hereto, recognize that there is a need for such governmental units to consult among themselves to act in concert and to jointly exercise the powers of local government with reference to regional matters affecting health, safety, welfare, education, transportation, recreation, economic conditions, regional planning or regional development; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina, Chapter 160A, Article 20, Parts 1 and 2, the following Resolution is hereby adopted for the establishment of a regional council of governments and for the joint exercise of any power, function, public enterprise, right, privilege or immunity of local government by and through this regional council and its member governmental units, all to the extent and in the manner authorized or permitted by Article 20 of Chapter 160A of the General Statutes of North Carolina entitled "Interlocal Cooperation".

ITEM I

<u>Short Title - Binding Effect</u>: This Resolution shall be hereafter referred to as the "Charter" of the Centralina Council of Governments; and said Charter, together with all amendments thereto, shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of all governmental units who are now or hereafter become its members.

ITEM II

<u>Name</u>: The name of the regional council of governments hereby established shall be the **CENTRALINA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS**, and shall be hereinafter referred to herein as the "Council".

ITEM III

Membership:

A. The initial membership of this Council of Governments shall consist of the following governmental units who are presently members of the Council and such additional units of local government admitted in accordance with the provisions of this Charter:

- B. Any municipal or county government which is not an initial member of the Council, including any municipal or county government in a state adjoining North Carolina (where permitted by the laws of said adjoining state) may join the Council by ratifying or adopting this Charter and upon the majority vote of the existing members. Notice of such application for admission shall be given each member in the manner prescribed by the Council Bylaws at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the meeting at which the vote is to be taken.
- C. All rights and privileges of membership in the Council shall be exercised on behalf of the member governments by their delegates to the Council; and "delegates" as used in this Charter shall, unless otherwise provided, include alternate delegates duly designated by a member government.

ITEM IV

Purpose and Functions: The Council hereby established shall be a voluntary organization of local governmental units organized and existing to (1) provide a framework within which matters affecting the health, safety, welfare, education, recreation, economic conditions, transportation, water quality and solid waste, regional planning or regional development of and for the citizens within the member governmental units may be studied and discussed, and concerning which solutions or recommendations are proposed; (2) to implement courses of action relating to the matters within its jurisdiction through the joint exercise or contractual exercise by one unit for other units of any power, function, right, privilege or immunity of local government; (3) to promote intergovernmental cooperation, communication and planning; and (4) to review, upon the request of state, federal or local governments, or agencies thereof, applications for grants or funds for projects affecting citizens within the members' jurisdictions.

ITEM V

Representation:

- A. Each member governmental unit shall be represented in the Council by one delegate or in the absence of such delegate by a designated alternate, if any. All delegates and alternates shall be elected members of the governing bodies of the member governmental units they represent. The delegates and alternates, as well as their successors, shall be selected by the member governments in any manner consistent with law and the regulations governing such body, and their names shall be certified to the Council in the manner prescribed by the Bylaws of the Council. Each governmental unit may designate any number of alternate delegates.
- B. The term of office of each delegate shall commence upon the selection and certification of the delegate to the Council by the respective member government; and such delegate shall continue to represent the member government until a successor delegate is certified, unless the delegate shall sooner resign, cease to be an elected member of said governing body, or be removed as a delegate by said governing body, in which case his term shall expire on the effective date of such event. Only an individual who has been duly appointed and certified to the Council as a delegate or alternate may be permitted to vote in any matter. The members shall also appoint and certify a successor to fill any vacancy created by the death, removal, resignation, or ineligibility of a delegate (but not an alternate), but an alternate may represent a member until such successor delegate is appointed and certified.

ITEM VI

Voting and Quorum Requirements:

- A. Except as provided in paragraph D of this Item, each member governmental unit shall be entitled to one vote on all matters coming before the Council or before any committee to which such member unit is duly appointed. All votes shall be cast by the delegate, or in his absence, by an alternate delegate of the member government.
- B. A quorum shall be present for the transaction of business of the Council at any meeting at which there is representation of either (a) a majority of all the member governmental units or (b) fifty percent (50%) of the county member governmental units and thirty percent (30%) of the total number of member municipal governmental units.
- C. The affirmative vote of a majority of representatives present at any meeting at which a quorum was present shall be required for any action or recommendation of the Council or any committee, unless this Charter or the Bylaws of the Council require a larger affirmative vote on particular matters. Voting shall be by voice, a show of hands or, upon the request of any three delegates, by a poll of the delegates.
- D. Any member governmental unit shall be entitled to request that any matter requiring a vote of the Council be considered by weighted voting in accordance with the following procedures:

- 1. A request for weighted voting must be made after the motion is made and before any vote on the motion is taken.
- 2. The vote on any matter appearing on the written agenda for the meeting, and upon which weighted voting has been requested, must be taken at that meeting unless the vote is postponed by a two-thirds non-weighted vote of the delegates.
- 3. Each member governmental unit shall be entitled to cast one vote for each 50,000 residents of its jurisdiction (or portion thereof) as determined by the census used in assessing members' dues for the current fiscal year. A simple majority of the votes cast shall be required for passage of any motion unless the Charter or Bylaws require a larger affirmative vote on particular matters.
- 4. Anything contained in these weighted voting procedures to the contrary notwithstanding, if on any motion utilizing weighted voting any three (3) county member governments shall cast negative votes, the motion shall fail unless the motion would have carried without the use of weighted voting.
- 5. All votes on issues where weighted voting is requested shall be taken by a poll of the delegates.

ITEM VII

<u>Withdrawal</u>: Any member may withdraw from the Council at the end of any fiscal year, provided written notice of intent to withdraw is given to each of the other members at least six (6) months prior to the end of the fiscal year.

ITEM VIII

<u>Powers and Duties of the Council</u>: Within the limits of funds and personnel available, the Council:

A. Shall have and may exercise, in accordance with its Charter and Bylaws, all of the powers which the General Assembly of North Carolina has authorized, and may hereafter from

time to time authorize this Charter to confer upon the Council, including, but not limited to, all of the specific powers enumerate in Section 160A-475 (and any amendments thereto) of the General Statutes of North Carolina, which powers are incorporated herein by reference. Similarly, to the

extent applicable, any powers authorized hereafter by the General Assembly of a state adjoining North Carolina may be exercised by the Council with respect to interstate activities or functions.

- **B.** Shall have, and may exercise, in addition to and not in limitation of the foregoing, the following powers:
- 1. To create such committees as it deems necessary to exercise the powers granted to the Council herein in dealing with problems or problem areas that do not involve all the members of the Council. At least one delegate from each member governmental unit affected by the problem or

problem area to be dealt with by the committee is entitled to be a member of that committee. Any two or more member governmental units shall have the right to have a Council committee formed to exercise the powers of the Council with reference to any problem which affects the petitioning governmental units, unless the Council shall reasonably determine that the problem or problem area in question should be assigned to an existing committee, in which case the petitioning members shall be entitled to be represented on said committee. The subject matter over which any committee has jurisdiction to exercise the powers of the Council shall be specifically defined, but may be enlarged or restricted by the Council from time to time. Unless the right of a member to representation on any particular committee granted hereinabove is asserted, the Chairman of the Council shall designate the membership of all committees.

- 2. To accept, receive and disburse in furtherance of the duties, purposes, powers, and functions specified in this Charter all member assessments, funds, grants, and services made available by the State of North Carolina, any other state, or any agency thereof, the Federal Government and its agencies, any municipality or county or agency thereof, the Federal Government and its agencies, any municipality or county or other governmental or quasi-governmental unit or agency (whether or not a member of such Council) and private and civic sources. The Council may provide matching funds, grants, or services, received from any source, to or for any governmental or quasi-governmental agencies established by the Council or any two or more member governmental units in furtherance of the duties, purposes, powers, and functions herein contained. None of the powers contained in this subparagraph may be exercised by any committee except with respect to funds budgeted or appropriated for their use by the Council.
- **3.** To meet with, consult with, contract with or act in concert with any county or municipality or any agency of any state, the federal government, any civic organization, or private organization in the furtherance of the purposes and objects within its jurisdiction.
- **4.** To participate, as a unit of local government, in any undertaking with any other unit of local government, whether or not a member of the Council, for the joint exercise of governmental powers in accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 160A, Article 20, Part 1 of the General Statutes of North Carolina (and any amendments thereto), entitled "Interlocal Cooperation".
- **5.** To contract with any government entity or agency, or any other person, firm or corporation for goods and/or services when same have been authorized by budget appropriations or by special resolution of the Council appropriating available funds; and to purchase and own such personal property, equipment, vehicles and furnishings as may be authorized or for which funds may be appropriated.
- **6.** To adopt Bylaws containing such rules and regulations for the conduct of its business as it may deem necessary for the proper discharge of its duties and the performance of its functions, not inconsistent with the Charter or the laws of North Carolina.
- 7. To create agencies of the Council to act for and on behalf of the Council in the planning and development of particular programs which affect the health, safety, welfare, education, economic conditions or regional development of two or more member governmental units. Such agencies

have such membership, staff, powers, duties and responsibilities as may be specified in the Council Resolutions pursuant to which such agency is established, consistent with the powers herein granted to the Council. Provided, however, such agency shall at all times be acting for and on behalf of, and shall be responsible to, the Council. The Council may appropriate funds for the use of agency programs which it has received from any source, including member assessments, provided such appropriation is made in accordance with this Charter.

8. To contract with other units of local government, as that term is defined in G.S. 160A-460, to provide for administrative, planning, procurements or other services, including administration of grants from local, state and federal agencies, in order to promote and encourage interlocal cooperation authorized under G.S. 160A-461.

ITEM IX

Financial:

- **A.** The general operating expenses of the Council shall be paid from funds paid to the Council by each member governmental unit. The annual contribution of each member governmental unit shall be based upon the duly adopted budget for such year and shall be assessed on the basis of the population for each member. For the purpose of determining the current population of each governmental unit, the Council shall use either (1) the <u>Population Estimates for North Carolina Municipalities and Counties</u> prepared by the United States Bureau of the Census and the North Carolina Office of State Budget and Management and published from time to time or (2) the official 10 year census figures. The current population estimates are the most recent estimates available using either (1) or (2) above, on the date the annual dues for member governments is determined by the Council.
- **B.** All expenditures of the Council for special projects of the Council or any committee thereof or for performance of contractual services for non-member units of local government shall be made from revenues paid to the Council by the governmental units directly involved in such projects. All such revenues shall be credited to a special revenue account and all expenditures made at the completion of any project or contract. In no case shall other general fund revenues be used to pay any special project costs which do not reasonably involve or benefit the entire Council. In the event payments made by other units of local government exceed or are less than the actual cost of a special project, the excess shall be refunded to and the deficit paid by the units of local governments affected thereby.
- C. The budget for the Council for each fiscal year and the assessment of each member shall be adopted by the affirmative vote of at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the representatives present at a meeting at which a quorum was present, provided notice of such vote has been given in accordance with the Bylaws, and provided further said notice is accompanied by a copy of the proposed budget and assessment.
- **D.** The budget for the Council and the assessment for each member governmental unit shall be adopted by the Council no later than April 15th of each year. Provided, the Council shall publish

and deliver to the delegates a budget estimate, indicating each member governmental unit's estimated share thereof, on or before March 31st of each year, if the actual budget shall not have been adopted by that date.

- **E.** The budget, once adopted, may be amended by the affirmative vote of at least seventy-five percent (75%) of the representatives present at a meeting at which a quorum was present, provided notice of such vote has been given in accordance with the Bylaws, and provided, further, said notice shall state in detail the proposed terms of the amendment and the reasons therefor.
- **F.** The annual assessment for each member governmental unit shall be payable on or before August 1st of each year and shall be delinquent thereafter. Any member of the Council which becomes delinquent in the payment of its annual assessments shall lose all rights and privileges of Council membership during such a period of delinquency. Any new member shall pay the full annual assessment for the current fiscal year regardless of its date of admission.
- **G.** All revenues paid to the Council by member governmental units and all other sources whatsoever shall be deposited in the general fund of the Council, and separate revenue and expenditure accounts shall be maintained for each phase of operation of the Council to the extent required by sound accounting practices, to include, but not to be limited to, such accounts for the general operating expenses of the Council and each special project undertaken by the Council or any committee thereof.
- **H.** The general operating expenses of the Council shall include, but are not necessarily limited to: providing meeting and office space or other such physical facilities needed by the Council or any committee thereof; providing compensation for the director and other administrative personnel of the Council; providing the necessary legal and accounting or other professional services; providing furniture, equipment, vehicles and supplies, paying special consultants, temporary employees and contractors duly authorized by the Council; reimbursing authorized expenses of Council employees.
- **I.** Unless the Council shall otherwise provided by resolution, any surplus funds in the general operating expense account at the close of any fiscal year shall be credited as additional revenue for budget purposes for the following fiscal year. All other funds shall be held and disbursed as otherwise herein provided or as directed by the contributing source.

ITEM X

Compensation and Expenses of Delegates:

A. Except for the Chairman of the Council, a delegate, and in his absence, an alternate delegate may receive, if the Bylaws so provide, up to \$40.00 for each regular or special meeting of the Council and Executive Committee attended, not to exceed \$500.00 during any fiscal year. Such Bylaws may also provide that actual travel expenses, not to exceed twenty-five cents (\$.25) per mile, may be paid to each delegate, and in his absence to one alternate delegate, for attending any meeting of the Council or any committee meeting. The Chairman of the Council shall receive \$200.00 per month as compensation for his services to the Council.

B. For travel on any authorized business of the Council, other than to attend Council or committee meetings, delegates shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses, as approved by the Council.

ITEM XI

<u>Severability</u>: If any Item, paragraph, sentence or phase of this Charter shall be declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be in violation of the laws of this State or, where applicable, of the laws of any other state, such provisions of this Charter shall be considered to be severable, as to the member or members affected, and the validity of the remaining portion of the Charter shall not be affected.

ITEM XII

Amendment of Charter and Dissolution of Council:

- **A.** The Council may formally recommend to the member governments a resolution to amend the Charter by affirmative vote of at least three-fourths of the representatives present at any meeting at which a quorum was present, provided notice of such vote has been given in accordance with the Bylaws. Said amendment shall become effective when the resolution has been duly adopted by three-fourths of the member governmental units.
- **B.** The Council may be dissolved at the end of any fiscal year only (1) upon adoption of a dissolution resolution by three-fourths of the governing bodies of all governmental units, or (2) the withdrawal from the Council of all but one of the member governmental units. If such dissolution is effected by resolution of the member governments, such resolution shall specify the method of liquidating the Council's assets and liabilities. If such dissolution is occasioned by withdrawal of all but one member, the remaining governmental unit shall have the power to liquidate all assets and liabilities and it shall then distribute the net proceeds, if any, to those members who paid the latest annual assessment and in the same proportion. Any deficit shall be the responsibility of those member governments who would have received the next proceeds, and in the same proportions.

ITEM XIII

Effective Date: The effective date of this Restated Charter shall be July 1, 1989, as to the current membership; and as to all subsequent members, this Charter shall be effective on the date of its adoption by the governing body of such governmental unit or the date such member's application was approved, whichever shall be later.

CENTRALINA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS

BYLAWS August 12, 2009

The Centralina Council of Governments (the "Council"), organized and existing as a Regional Council of Governments under and pursuant to Chapter 160A, Article 20. Part 2 of the General Statutes of North Carolina, does hereby ratify, confirm and adopt the following articles as and for the Bylaws of this Council, replacing all Bylaws previously adopted by the Council:

Article I: DEFINITIONS

- A. <u>Charter</u> The identical concurrent resolution adopted by the members of this Council and establishing this Council, as same may be duly amended from time to time.
- **B.** <u>Council</u> The Centralina Council of Governments (the "Council") having its principal administrative offices in Mecklenburg County. North Carolina.
- C. <u>Member</u> Any municipal or county governmental unit which has adopted the Charter of the Council and shall have received the approval of the existing Council members.
- D. <u>Affiliate Member</u> Any municipal or county governmental unit or quasi-governmental agency is eligible for and may be admitted as an affiliate member as provided in the Charter.
- **E. Delegate** An elected member of the governing body of each member governmental unit who shall have been designated by such member to represent it on the Council and whose name has been certified to the Council in accordance with the Bylaws. Except where a contrary intent appears, "delegate" as used herein shall be deemed to include "alternate delegate".
- F. <u>Alternate or Alternate Delegate</u> An elected member of the governing body of any governmental unit who shall have been designated by such member to represent it on the

Council in the absence of the principal delegate and whose name has been certified to the Council in accordance with the Bylaws.

Article II: REPRESENTATION AND VOTING

A. <u>Certification of Delegates and Alternates</u>: All members shall, prior to each December meeting of the Council, certify to the Council the names and mailing addresses of their delegate and one alternate delegate who have been selected to represent such member on the Council, commencing at the December meeting of the Council. Such delegate or alternate shall serve until the following December meeting, or until his or her successor shall be duly designated and certified. Any alternate shall be a member of the governing body of the member governmental unit.

B. Voting:

- 1. Except as provided in the Charter Resolution of the Council, each member shall be entitled to one vote on all matters before the Council and any committee to which such member may be appointed. The vote of each member shall be personally cast by its delegate or alternate, provided no alternate may vote on matters before the Executive Board.
- 2. Voting by delegates shall be by voice or by show of hands at the discretion of the presiding officer of the Council. Provided, however, upon the request of any three delegates, made before or immediately after a voice or show of hands vote, the vote shall be by a poll of the delegates.

Article III: MEMBERSHIP

A. Admission of New Members: Any municipal or county government in North Carolina or any other state shall be eligible for full voting membership in this Council. Any governmental unit desiring membership shall so notify the Executive Director of the Council in writing and shall state by resolution that it has ratified the Charter of the Council. Thereafter, the

Executive Director shall cause such application to be placed on the agenda for the Council's next meeting. Membership of the applicant shall be effective on the date of the acceptance of its application by the affirmative vote of a majority of the existing Council membership. All members shall be bound by the Council's Charter and Bylaws and all actions of the Council consistent therewith.

- B. Affiliate Membership: An Affiliate Membership may be granted any municipal or county governmental unit not desiring full membership, or any quasi-governmental agency involved in matters affecting the health, safety, welfare or education of the citizens of North Carolina or any adjoining state. Such affiliate memberships shall continue at the will of the Council and shall not be eligible to vote. An Affiliate Member may be charged a membership fee as approved by the Executive Board.
- c. Withdrawal of a Member: Any member of the Council may withdraw or terminate its membership on the Council effective at the end of any fiscal year (June 30) by timely notifying all members of the Council of its intent to terminate its membership. A certified copy of the resolution of withdrawal of the governing body of the member shall be attached to such notice. The notice shall be sent to the delegate of each of the other Council members, not later than January 1 preceding the end of the fiscal year for which the member's withdrawal is to be effective. A member withdrawing shall not be entitled to any rebate for the current fiscal year. Timely and proper notice of withdrawal may not be waived by the Council. Upon the failure of such member to give the prescribed notice in compliance with the law of North Carolina, and the Charter and these Bylaws, such member shall continue to be a member until the end of the fiscal year in which timely and proper notice is given. Such member shall also be

responsible for the payment of all annual dues and/or assessments until the end of the fiscal year in which its withdrawal was properly and timely noticed.

Article IV: CONTRACTS, EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS, EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS

A. Approval of Contracts:

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in these Bylaws, all contracts, agreements or other instruments which (a) require the performance of staff services or the expenditure of the Council's general operating revenue obtained through member assessment and are in an amount or value of more than \$50,000 or (b) relate to the use of federal, state, and/or local funds in an amount or value of more than \$200,000, shall first be submitted to and approved by the Executive Board of the Council. All such contracts shall be consistent with the resolution of the Executive Board and the Council's adopted budget.
- 2. The Executive Director, or in his absence the Chair of the Council, shall be authorized to approve and contract for (a) the expenditure of general operating revenue in the amount or value of \$50,000 or less, (b) the expenditures of federal, state and/or local funds of \$200,000 or less. Provided in either case such contracts shall be consistent with the budget as adopted or as amended.
- 3. The Executive Director is authorized to approve and contract for services to be provided to member governments at cost, regardless of amount or value, provided the service agreement entered into by the Executive Director is reported to the Executive Board at its next meeting.
- 4. Except as specifically set forth in these Bylaws to the contrary, no member, officer, or employee of the Council shall have the authority to bind or obligate the Council with

respect to any matter whatever or to expend any funds of the Council without the specific approval and authority of the Council.

- 5. All contracts, agreements, or other instruments to which the Council is a party shall be submitted to the Council's attorney for approval as to form prior to execution thereof.
- 6. Any and all contracts or other instruments to which the Council is a party shall be executed in the name of the Council by the Executive Director, Assistant Director, the Chair, or the Vice Chair.

Article V: COMPENSATION OF DELEGATES

- A. <u>Delegates Compensation</u>: The Council shall pay to the delegate representing each governmental unit, or in his absence to one alternate delegate, as compensation for attending regular and special meetings of the Council and the Executive Board, an amount which is periodically approved by the Council, consistent with the Charter Resolution. This provision shall not be applicable to the Chair of the Council, whose compensation is provided for in the Charter.
- **B.** The Council shall, upon the written request of a delegate, reimburse reasonable travel expenses while the delegate is away from home attending to official business of the Council.

Article VI: COMMITTEES

A. <u>Standing Advisory Committees</u>: The Executive Board may establish standing committees of delegates and other persons who shall serve as advisory committees to the Executive Board and may set forth the general duties and responsibilities of the committee, the membership, term thereof, and such special responsibilities as the Executive Board may wish to assign the committee. Any delegate may attend any meeting of any standing committee, but

only the duly designated members thereof shall be entitled to vote. Nothing herein shall be construed to require any particular matter be referred to any Standing Advisory Committee prior to decision thereon by the Executive Board, and the Executive Board shall not be bound by any recommendation of any advisory committee. The Vice Chair of the Council shall be an exofficio member of all standing committees with voice and vote.

B. Ad Hoc Committees: The Chair may establish such advisory committees as he or she may deem advisable which shall advise the Executive Director, staff, the standing committees and the Council as to particular matters. The members of such committees shall be appointed by and shall serve at the will of the Chair; and the membership of such advisory committees shall not be limited to the Council delegates.

Article VII: EXECUTIVE BOARD

- A. Membership: The Executive Board shall be composed of: (1) The officers of the Council, (2) the delegate from each County member government, (3) the delegate from the City of Charlotte, and (4) one municipal delegate from each County area representing all municipalities within such county, including one to represent the municipalities in Mecklenburg County other than the City of Charlotte. Provided, however, if a county, a county area, or the City of Charlotte has a delegate who is an officer of the Council, that unit shall not be entitled to an additional representative on the Executive Board. The municipal delegates from all municipal member government units within each county area (excluding the City of Charlotte delegate as to Mecklenburg County) shall elect from their number by caucus at the first Council meeting of the calendar year, the municipal delegate from the county area to serve on the Executive Board. Only delegates (not alternates) may serve on the Executive Board.
- B. <u>Voting</u>. Each member of the Executive Board shall be entitled to one vote on any matter coming before the Executive Board. A quorum shall consist of one-half of the current

members of the Executive Board; and all issues shall be determined by a simple majority of those present and voting. Provided, however, if a quorum is present at any meeting of the Executive Board, any member of the Executive Board not physically present at the meeting may attend the meeting by electronic or other means of remote communication that allows the member (a) to hear the meeting proceedings and to be heard substantially concurrently as the proceedings occur, and (b) to vote on matters which are before the Executive Board.

C. <u>Term of Membership</u>: The term of membership for all delegates on the Executive Board shall commence following the December Council meeting, and the delegate shall serve until his or her successor is selected and qualified. Should any delegate cease to be an elected public official, that person shall no longer be eligible to be a delegate or to serve on the Executive Board. Vacancies created by death, resignation or otherwise shall be filled in the same manner as required for the selection of the member.

D. Meetings:

- 1. **Procedure:** All meetings of the Executive Board and the Council shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of <u>Robert's Rules of Order</u> except as otherwise provided in the Charter or these Bylaws. The Chair, or if absent, then the Vice-Chair, then the Secretary, then the Treasurer, in descending order, shall preside over all meetings of the Council.
- 2. Time and Place: The Executive Board shall meet during the months of January. March, April, June. September and October at the time and place fixed by the Executive Board from time to time. Notice of the regular meeting must be given to each member at least five (5) business days prior to the meeting. A special meeting of the Executive Board may be called by the Chair of the Council. the Executive Director or any three (3) members of the Executive Board by causing notice thereof to be given to each member at least five (5) business days prior

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to such special meeting. The notice of a special meeting shall contain an agenda of matters upon which action by the Executive Board is requested; and no action may be taken by the Executive Board at such special meeting on matters not on the published agenda. Minutes of each regular or special meeting of the Executive Board shall be distributed to the members of the Executive Board no later than ten (10) business days following the meeting.

- E. <u>Duties, Powers and Responsibilities</u>: In addition to those specifically delegated to the Executive Board by resolution of the Council, the Executive Board shall have the following duties, powers and responsibilities:
- 1. The Executive Board shall review, and may revise, amend, increase or decrease the proposed annual operating budget prepared by the Executive Director. After the adoption of the budget and the member assessment by the Council, the Executive Board shall exercise oversight of all expenditures in accordance with the budget.
- 2. The Executive Board shall have the power to transfer or reallocate funds within the operating budget and amend the operating budget in order to meet unanticipated needs or changed conditions.
- 3. The Executive Board shall have the authority to employ, fix the salary of, and discharge the Executive Director, who shall serve at the pleasure of the Executive Board. Employment, promotion, demotion, and discharge of all other employees shall be the responsibility of the Executive Director.
- 4. The Executive Board may act on behalf of the Council on all matters affecting the Council, except for (1) the adoption of the annual budget and work plan or (2) the fixing of the member assessment.

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Article VIII: COUNCIL MEETINGS

- A. Time and Place: The Council shall hold a regular meeting on the second Wednesday of the months of February, May, August and December at such time and place as shall be designated by the Executive Director. The February meeting is the Annual Meeting for the purpose of reviewing the annual report for the activities of the preceding fiscal year. The Chair or Executive Board may change the day of any regular meeting, but not the month, provided notice of such change is given to each delegate at least ten (10) business days prior to the regularly scheduled meeting. Special meetings of the Council may be called by the Executive Board, and shall be called by the Chair upon the written request of at least five (5) delegates. Notice of any special meeting shall be given to each delegate not less than five (5) business days prior thereto; and such notice shall specifically set forth the purpose of such special meeting and the matters to be considered at such meeting. Matters not contained in the notice of a special meeting may not be considered.
- **B.** Notices: Notices of any regularly scheduled meeting shall be given to each delegate not less than five (5) days prior thereto setting forth the time and place of such meeting. Such notice shall also contain an agenda of matters to be considered at such regular meeting, but the Council may consider any matter, irrespective of whether or not such matter appeared on the agenda.
- C. Consent Agenda Items: Agenda items deemed by the Executive Director to be routine matters which are appropriate for consideration by the Council without discussion may be placed on a "consent agenda" which will be part of the meeting agenda distributed to the Delegates in accordance with the bylaws. All items on the "consent agenda" may be considered upon one motion and without discussion. Provided, however, at any time prior to the vote on the motion, any delegate may request that any one or more items be removed from the consent

agenda; and the presiding officer shall then advise the Council, before the vote, that the requested items have been removed. Any item removed from the consent agenda shall be considered at such later time in the meeting as the presiding officer shall deem appropriate, or, upon a vote of delegates, it may be deferred for consideration to the next Council meeting.

Article IX: OFFICERS

- A. <u>Designation and Term</u>: The Council officers shall consist of a Chair, a Vice-Chair, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, who shall be elected in November by the Council for a term of one year, or until their successors are elected, which term shall commence upon their installation at the December meeting of the Council. In addition, the immediate past Chair of the Council shall continue to serve as an officer of the Council as long as he or she remains a delegate.
- B. <u>Nominating Committee and Election</u>: The Executive Board, at its meeting in October of each year, shall appoint a nominating committee of three (3) delegates who shall submit to the Council the names of proposed officers at the December meeting of the Council, at which meeting the election shall be held. Nominations from the floor may be made. The person receiving the highest number of votes cast for each office shall be deemed elected.
- C. <u>Duties of Chair</u>: To preside over all meetings of the Council and its Executive Board and exercise such other duties and authority as otherwise set out in the Charter or these Bylaws or in resolutions of the Executive Board or the Council: to execute such instruments, contracts, or other documents in the name of the Council, as herein set out or as otherwise authorized; to supervise the Executive Director of the Council in the performance of his or her

duties; and to perform such other tasks as required herein or as directed by the Executive Board or the Council.

- **D.** <u>Duties of Vice-Chair</u>: To perform the duties of the Chair when the Chair is absent or unavailable for the performance of his duties, or such other duties as shall be delegated by the Executive Board or the Council. The Vice Chair of the Council shall serve as ex-officion member of all standing committees with voice and vote.
- **E.** <u>Duties of Secretary</u>: To keep or supervise the keeping of all records of meetings; to supervise the taking of minutes of the meetings; to submit the minutes at all meetings; and to perform such other tasks as required herein or as directed by the Executive Board or the Council.
- F. <u>Duties of Treasurer</u>: To supervise all financial matters of the Council; to cause the yearly audit to be made and to report on the audit to the Council; and to perform such other tasks as required herein or as directed by the Executive Board or the Council.

Article X: FINANCIAL

- A. <u>Fiscal Control</u>: The accounting and fiscal control procedure shall be in accordance with the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act of North Carolina as amended from time to time, anything contained herein to the contrary notwithstanding.
- B. <u>Budget Estimate</u>: The budget and the proposed member assessment for such year, as approved by the Executive Board, shall be distributed to each delegate at least ten (10) business days prior to the May meeting of the Council, at which meeting a public hearing on the budget shall be held, the proposed budget considered, and the budget and member assessment adopted by the Council.
- C. <u>Banking</u>: The Treasurer shall recommend and the Executive Board shall select one or more corporate banking institutions in the State of North Carolina to be the depository of

the funds of the Council. Excepted as hereinafter provided checks, drafts, and other orders for the payment of money, drawn in the name of the Council against Council funds in such depository or depositories shall be honored and charged to Council funds when the same shall bear the signatures of (a) the Executive Director, Assistant Director, Finance Officer, or Deputy Finance Officer, and (b) the Chair or the Treasurer of the Council. Provided, any two of the following, to wit: the Executive Director, Assistant Director, Finance Officer, or Deputy Finance Officer are specifically authorized to sign all checks and electronic payments generated for (a) payroll and benefit-related expenditures, (b) passthrough grant-funded programs expenditures. (c) expenditures specifically authorized by the budget (e.g., rent), and (d) any third party checks and electronic payments of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars or less. The Executive Board may by resolution authorize one or more persons who may disburse funds from specific and separate program accounts, so long as the Council secures full bonding of each person making such disbursements.

- **D.** Fiscal Year: The fiscal year of the Council shall begin July 1 of each calendar year and shall end June 30 of the following year.
- **E. Bonds:** All employees and officers of the Council authorized to handle or have custody of Council funds in excess of \$100.00 shall be bonded in an amount fixed by the Executive Board, but not less than \$10,000.00 nor more than \$100,000.00, under a blanket fidelity bond conditioned upon their faithful performance of their duties.
- F. <u>Chief Budget Officer and Chief Finance Officer</u>: The Executive Director shall serve as the Chief Budget Officer and as the Chief Finance Officer of the Council and shall perform such duties in these capacities as may be prescribed by the Local Government Budget and Fiscal Control Act, or by the Executive Board, not inconsistent therewith.

G. Annual Audit: The accounts of the Council shall be audited as soon as possible following the close of each fiscal year by certified public accountants. The auditor will be selected by the Executive Board and shall submit its report to the Council. The audit shall be conducted pursuant to a written contract, which should comply with the provisions of NCGS § 159-34.

H. <u>Authorization to Write off Uncollectible Accounts:</u> The Treasurer and the Executive Director of COG are authorized to approve write offs of uncollectible accounts receivable in the amount of \$100 or less.

Article XI: AMENDMENTS OF BYLAWS

These Bylaws may be altered or repealed and new Bylaws may be adopted by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the delegates present and voting at any meeting of the Council at which a quorum is present. Provided, however, that the notice of the Council meeting at which said proposed amendment shall be considered shall contain either the proposed amendment or a summary thereof and shall state that such amendment is to be considered at that meeting.

Article XII: NOTICES

Whenever the Charter, these Bylaws, a resolution of the Council or the laws of this state require (a) the giving of notice to the delegates of any meeting of the Council or of any other atter requiring notice to a member government or its delegate, or (b) require the dissemination of agendas, budgets or other materials to a member government or its delegate, such notice shall be written and may be disseminated by mail or electronically as authorized by the Electronic Commerce Act (N.C.G.S. §66-58.1 et seq.) and the Uniform Electronic Transaction Act (N.C.G.S. §66-33-311 et seq.). Such dissemination of notice shall be deemed to have been given

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when same has been either (a) addressed to the delegate at the mailing address certified to the


Council as the mailing address of such delegate, and deposited, postage prepaid, in the United

States mail, or (b) transmitted electronically to the electronic address of such delegate theretofore

certified to the Council.

The foregoing Bylaws, as amended this date, were duly adopted by the Centralina Council of

Governments at its regular meeting held August 12, 2009, and shall be effective upon adoption.

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
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THE STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION UNDER WHICH COUNCILS OF GOVERNMENTS ARE ORGANIZED

160A-470. Creation of regional councils; definition of "unit of local government". - (a) Any two or more units of local government may create a regional council of governments by adopting identical concurrent resolutions to that effect in accordance with the provisions and procedures of this Part. To the extent permitted by the laws of its state, a local government in a state adjoining North Carolina may participate in regional councils of governments organized under this Part to 'the same extent as if it were located in this State. The concurrent resolutions creating a regional council of governments, and any amendments thereto, will be referred to in the Part as the "charter" of the regional council.

(b) For the purposes of this Part, "unit of local government" means a county, city, or consolidated city-county.

160A-471. Membership. - Each unit of local government initially adopting a concurrent resolution under G.S. 160A-470 shall become a member of the regional council. Thereafter, any local government may join the regional council by ratifying its charter and by being admitted by a majority vote of the existing members. All of the rights and privileges of membership in a regional council of governments shall be exercised on behalf of its member governments by their delegates to the council.

160A-472. Contents of charter. - The charter of a regional council of governments shall:

- **1.** Specify the name of the council;
- 2. Establish the powers, duties, and functions that it may exercise and perform;
- 3. Establish the number of delegates to represent the member governments, fix their terms of office, provide methods for filling vacancies, and prescribe the compensation and allowances, if any, to be paid to delegates;
- **4**. Set out the method of determining the financial support that will be given to the council by each member government;
- 5. Establish a method for amending the charter, and for dissolving the council and liquidating its assets and liabilities.

In addition, the charter may, but need not, contain rules and regulations for the conduct of council business and any other matters pertaining to the organization, powers, and functioning of the council that the member governments deem appropriate.

160A-473. Organization of council. - Upon creation, a regional council shall meet at a time and place agreed upon by its member governments and shall organize by electing a chairman and any other officers that the charter may specify or the delegates may deem advisable. The council shall then adopt bylaws for the conduct of its business. All meetings of the council shall be open to the public.

160A-474. Withdrawal from council. - Any member government may withdraw from a regional council at the end of any fiscal year by giving at least 60 days' written notice to each of the other members. Withdrawal of a member government shall not dissolve the council if at least two members remain.

160A-475. Specific powers of council. - The charter may confer on the regional council any of the following powers:

- 1. To apply for, accept, receive, and disperse funds and grants made available to it by the State of North Carolina or any agency thereof, any unit of local government (whether or not a member of the council), and any private or civic agency;
- **2.** To employ personnel;
- **3.** To contract with consultants;
- **4.** To contract with the State of North Carolina, any other state, the United States of America, or any agency thereof, for services;
- **5.** To study regional governmental problems, including matters affecting health, safety, welfare, education, recreation, economic conditions, regional planning, and regional development;
- **6.** To promote cooperative arrangements and coordinate action among its member governments;
- **7.** To make recommendations for review and action to its member governments and other public agencies which perform functions within the region in which its member governments are located;
- **8.** Any other powers that are exercised or capable of exercise by its member governments and desirable for dealing with problems of mutual concern to the extent such powers are specifically delegated to it from time to time by resolution of the governing board of each of its member governments which are affected thereby.


160A-476. Fiscal affairs. - Each unit of local government having membership in a regional council may appropriate funds to the council from any legally available revenues. Services of personnel, use of equipment and office space, and other services may be made available to the council by its member governments as part of their financial support.

160A-477. Reports. - Each regional council shall prepare and distribute to its member governments and to the public an annual report of its activities including a financial statement.

160A-478. Powers granted are supplementary. - The powers granted to cities and counties by this article are supplementary to any powers heretofore or hereafter granted by any other general law, local act, or city charter for the same or similar purposes.

160A-479 to 160A-484. Reserved for future codification purposes.

COMMENTS BY GOVERNOR BOB SCOTT

Announcing Executive Order Number 3 Designating Seventeen Multi-County Planning Regions for North Carolina May 7, 1970

During the past several years, I have become more and more aware of the need for some type of uniform system of multi-county regions for planning and development activities of all levels of government in North Carolina.

We already have a variety of private and public planning and development organizations at town, county, multi-county, and regional levels. There are multi-county regional planning commissions and councils of governments.

The 29 counties in the Appalachian Program are divided into seven local development districts. There are three economic development districts in eastern North Carolina. Each of these districts has between six to ten counties.

We have 11 area-wide comprehensive health planning agencies and 19 comprehensive area manpower planning system areas. There are 21 local law enforcement planning units.

In addition to all of these organizations, the State has been divided over 70 different ways by State agencies for special purposes.

All of these organizations and divisions were created in response to real problems facing our towns, counties and cities. However, it should be obvious that the time has come for a more orderly approach to the organization of multi-county planning and development activities of the local, State and Federal agencies.

The provision of quality public services such as schools, health and medical facilities, libraries, highways, and police protection for all of our citizens must be coordinated at all levels of government.

The distinction between rural and urban America is becoming less and less meaningful. For years, our people have fled the rural areas in search of employment in the urban centers of the nation. Serious problems have resulted from this mass migration.

Now, with improved transportation and communication, large numbers of our people continue to live in rural areas and commute to the urban centers for employment and cultural, recreational, and entertainment activities. Thus, the trade areas of our larger cities and towns have been extended into the surrounding countryside.

We also see a trend for industry to decentralize so that, in varying degrees, our rural areas are now parts of larger economic communities. Urban centers provide many public and private services which would be extremely costly if provided in a sparsely settled rural community.

These economic communities, in almost every instance, encompass more than one county. This economic and social interdependence requires a spirit of cooperation between counties, municipalities, State and Federal governmental agencies as we prepare to meet the challenge of the year 2000.

I stated in my first legislative message to the General Assembly that only through partnership with the State can local governments provide the services our citizens demand and deserve. I also said that one of the highest priorities during my administration would be efforts to build an effective partnership between all levels of government.

Accordingly, the 1969 General Assembly passed legislation authorizing the North Carolina Department of Administration to work cooperatively with the counties, cities, towns, and Federal agencies to develop a system of multi-county planning regions.

Today, I am pleased to announce the designation of 17 multi-county planning regions for the State of North Carolina.

The good work that has been accomplished through present cooperative arrangements between counties and municipalities will not be displaced nor undermined by this uniform system of multi-county planning regions.

It is our desire to establish a framework within which individual communities can provide the needs of their residents and quicken the pace of development.

The staff of the State Planning Division under the direction of Mr. Ronald Scott in the Department of Administration has worked long and hard in studying ways to establish the regional boundaries that would take into account the interdependencies of the various counties, towns and cities.

The following factors were used in reaching a tentative decision about where boundaries should be established:

- 1. The economic and social interrelationships between urban centers and the surrounding areas,
- 2. Existing cooperative programs among counties and municipalities,
- 3. At least three counties in each region,
- 4. A population base of at least 100,000 people in each region, and
- 5. The existence of mountain ranges or rivers that might separate one region from another.

The establishment of the regional boundaries was not done in isolation at the State level. We have involved people from all levels of government. The Department of Local Affairs assisted the State Planning Division by holding a series of meetings across the State to explain the ideas and concepts to local officials and interested people.

A map showing tentative boundary lines was mailed to over 2,000 local government officials and other leaders interested in multi-county organizations of one form or another. We invited these officials to give us the benefit of their thinking and to express their wishes. Naturally, we were not disappointed in the number of responses that came back to us. Problem areas were identified from these comments and suggestions. Personnel in the State Planning Division resolved these problems through telephone conversations, and in many instances, personal visits with county commissioners.

Dr. William Turner, Director of Department of Administration, with my approval, appointed an advisory committee to council with the State Planning Division as they reached a final decision on boundary locations. This advisory committee, composed of representatives of the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners, the League of Municipalities, the Institute of Government, North Carolina State University, appropriate state agencies, and chaired by Dr. Leigh Hammond, North Carolina Field Director of the Coastal Plains Regional Commission, has played a key role in moderating the various points of view.

There is statutory authority for five different types of comprehensive multi-county organizations. These are:

- 1. Joint Planning arrangements among local planning boards
- 2. Regional Planning Boards
- 3. Economic Development Commissions
- 4. Planning and Economic Development Commissions
- 5. Council of Local Governments

It is possible that the next General Assembly will want to review the existing situation and see where additional legislation may be necessary in order for these planning regions to function effectively.

I would like to again emphasize that this system of planning regions will help achieve a goal which I have stated many times for my administration. This goal is to modernize and streamline government, particularly on a State and local level. I have said many times that State and local government must be strengthened, especially in its relation to the Federal government. We must have a stronger voice and a greater influence in the Federal system. These planning and development regions can serve a foundation for that strength.

As we move into the decade of the seventies and approach the dawn of a new century, we must have a unified effort to formulate programs that will lead to the good life for all North Carolinians.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 25

REGIONAL POLICY FOR NORTH CAROLINA

In 1970, this State delineated boundaries for multi-county planning and development regions and in 1971 a Lead Regional Organization was designated for each region to establish goals and objectives, and serve as the regional agent in dealing with state and federal agencies. Thereafter, state agencies were instructed to utilize the Lead Regional Organization for planning, implementing, and coordinating programs which impact local governments. The concepts of multi-county planning regions and the Lead Regional Organization policy have been very effective in fostering intergovernmental coordination and cooperation and this Administration is committed to close cooperation with local governments and their agencies. Therefore, by the authority vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of North Carolina, it is ORDERED:

Section 1. ORGANIZATION

- (a) A single Lead Regional Organization shall continue to exist in each of the eighteen multi-county planning development regions or such larger or smaller number of regions as may be hereinafter delineated by the Department of Administration.
- (b) The governing board of each Lead Regional Organization shall determine the organization's membership composition, but such Lead Regional Organizations are urged to limit policy board representation to elected officials of the member local governments.

Section 2. FUNCTIONS

(a) Lead Regional Organizations, whether Councils of Governments or Economic Development Districts shall have

the same powers and duties specified for Councils of Governments in the General Statutes of North Carolina.

Section 3. ADMINISTRATION

- (a) In dividing the State for administrative and/or service delivery purposes, State agencies shall make subdivisions coterminous with the Lead Regional Organization boundary lines, or with combinations of such, unless it can be demonstrated that strict conformance would result in inefficiencies, or that the proposed subdivision bears no relationship to regional plans or activities.
- (b) State agencies desiring to eliminate, re-direct, or begin programs which impact local governments through Lead Regional Organizations are hereby directed to submit any proposed change or modification to the Local Government Advocacy Council for an advisory opinion prior to taking action. New programs involving service delivery through the Lead Regional Organizations must have the approval of local governments affected.
- (c) State financial support to Lead Regional Organizations should be limited to grants to carry out specific tasks which are imposed by State government, or tasks which involve a coordinated state-wide activity which will be beneficial to both State and local governments. State funds, if provided, shall not be utilized for general administrative support, nor shall they be utilized to supplant local funds.
- (d) The determination of personnel procedures for Lead Regional Organizations shall be left to the discretion of local governments, and no State agency shall impose its personnel procedures on the Lead Regional Organizations. Nothing in this section shall preclude the establishment of reasonable minimum education and experience standards for positions funded by a State agency, provided that such standards shall be no more stringent than those in use by State or Federal agencies for comparable positions. The Lead Regional Organizations shall have complete autonomy in filling such positions from among applicants meeting those reasonable minimum standards.

Section 4. MODIFICATION OF REGIONAL BOUNDARIES

(a) The Secretary of the Department of Administration is hereby charged with revising and implementing, if necessary, the existing guidelines dealing with the changing of regional boundary lines, in accordance with the following:

- (b) Boundary changes shall not be considered unless a petition for change is received from one or more county boards of commissioners or from the governing bodies of one or more municipalities whose combined populations represent at least 50% of the county population. No boundary change shall be made until after notice of such proposed change is given, and sufficient opportunity for public comment is provided.
- (c) Any request for boundary change, shall be acted upon within ninety (90) days of the receipt of a valid . petition.
- (d) Approved boundary changes shall be effective on July 1st of the following year, and must be announced at least ninety days prior thereto.
- (e) A request for change which is not approved by the State shall not be reconsidered for a minimum period of three years from the date of disapproval.

Section 5. PRIOR ORDERS






