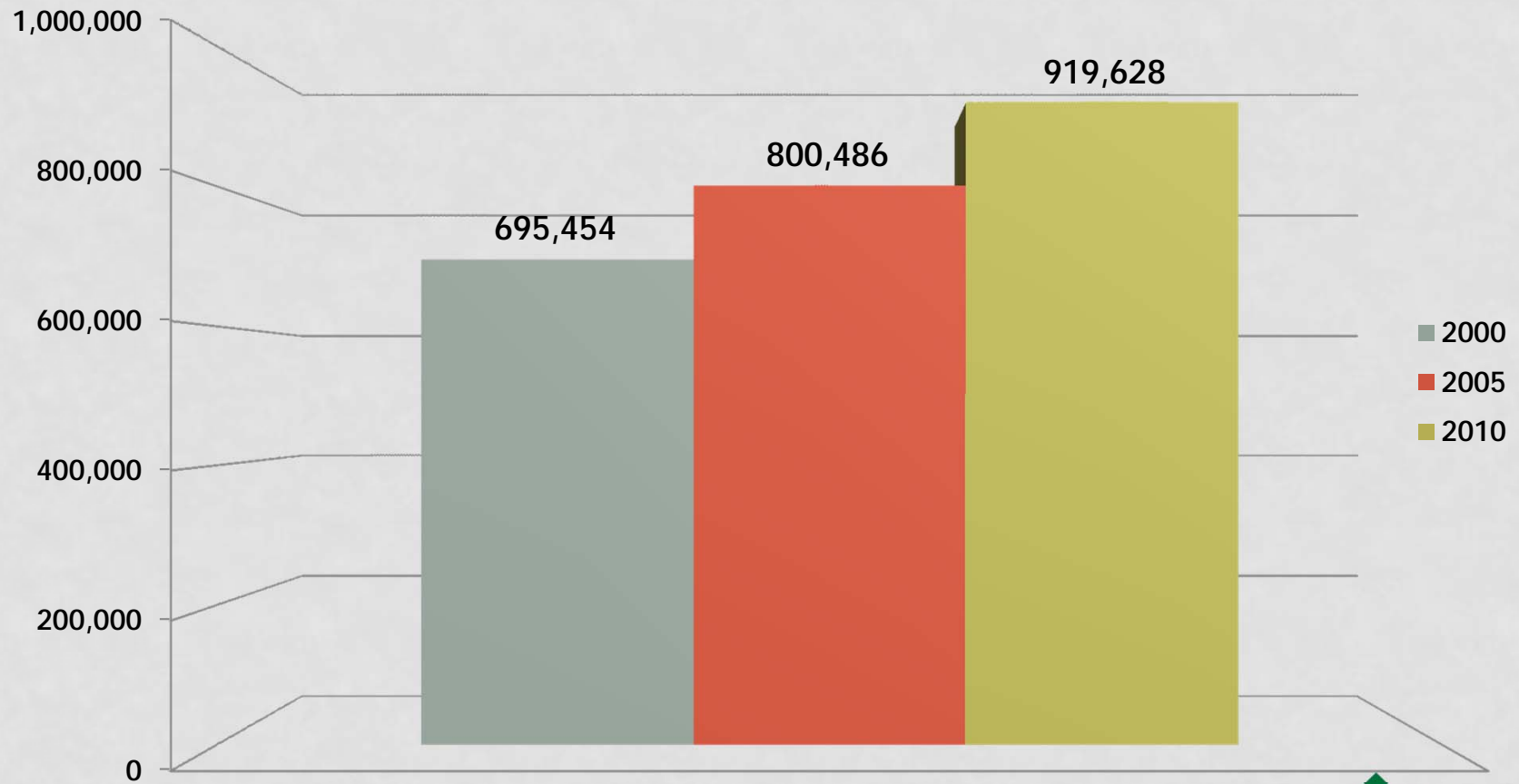

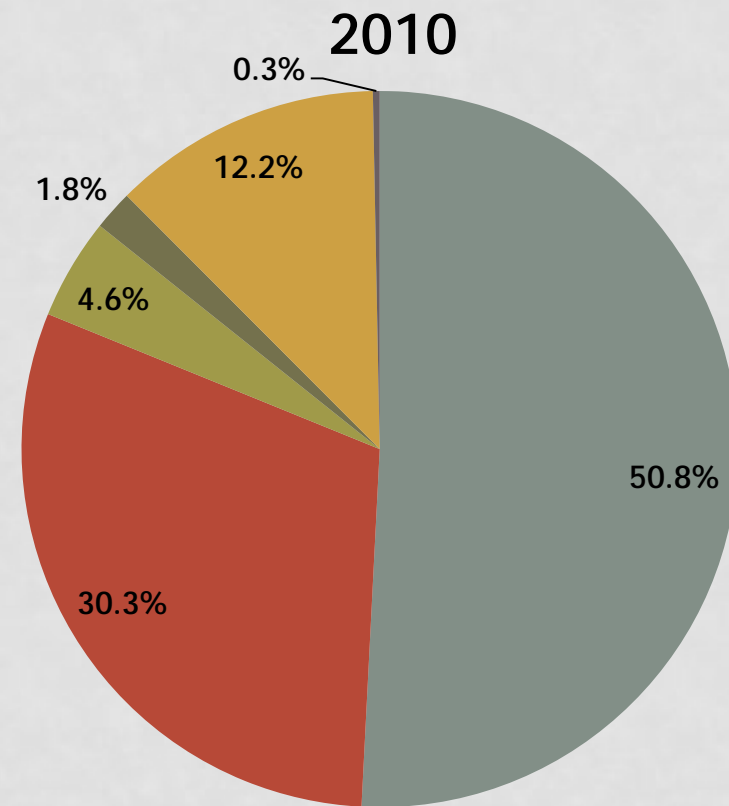
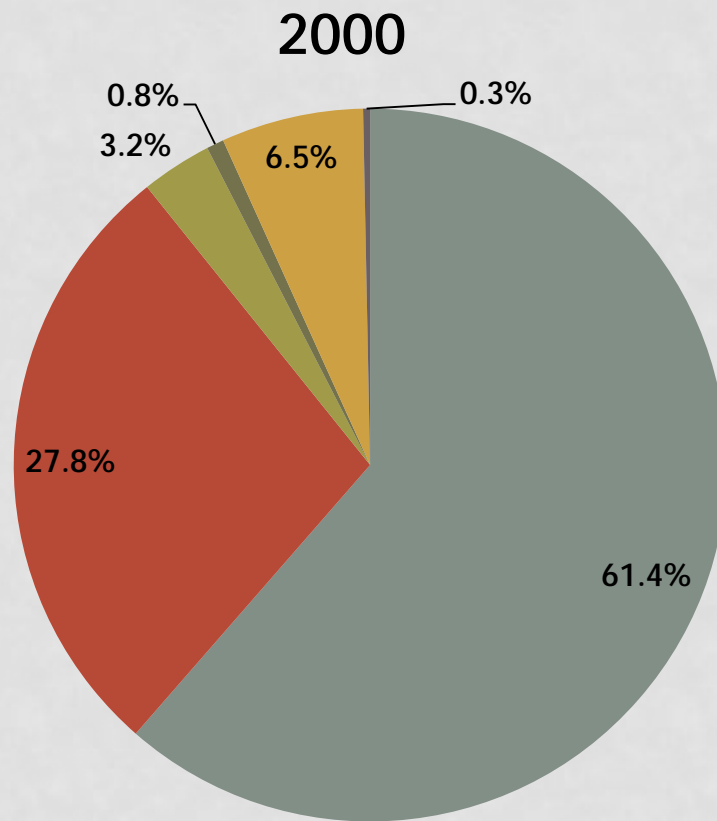

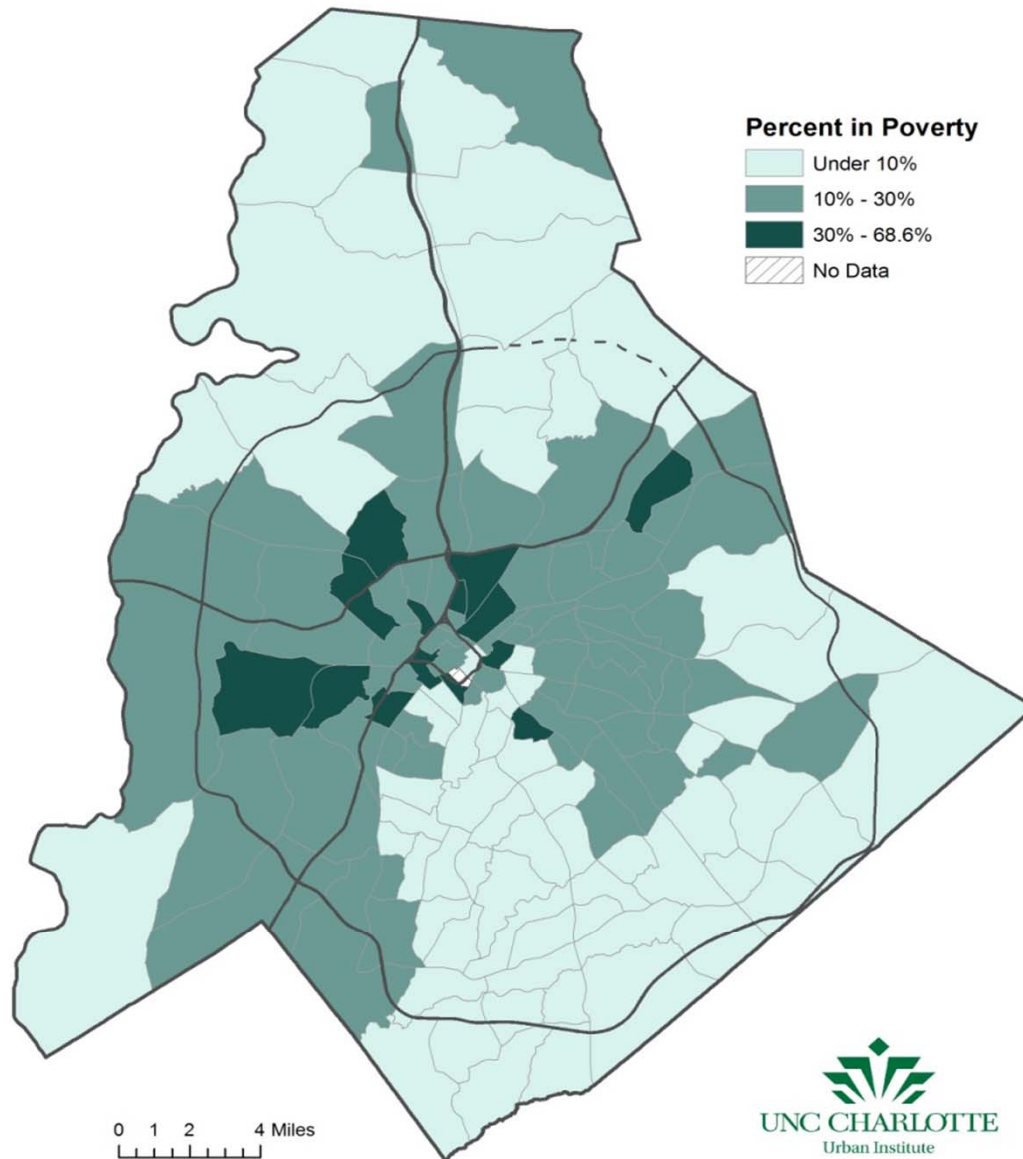
MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME



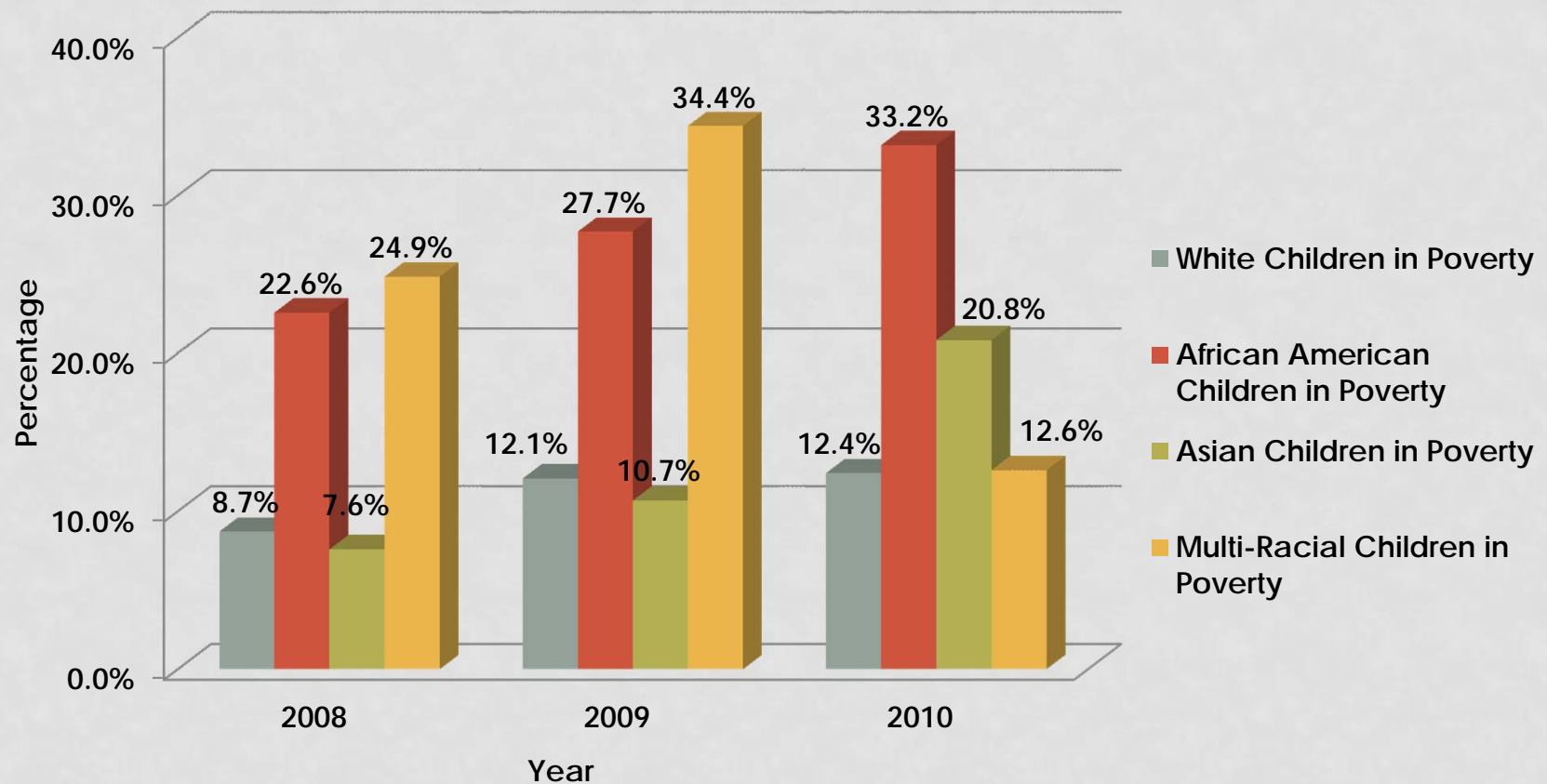

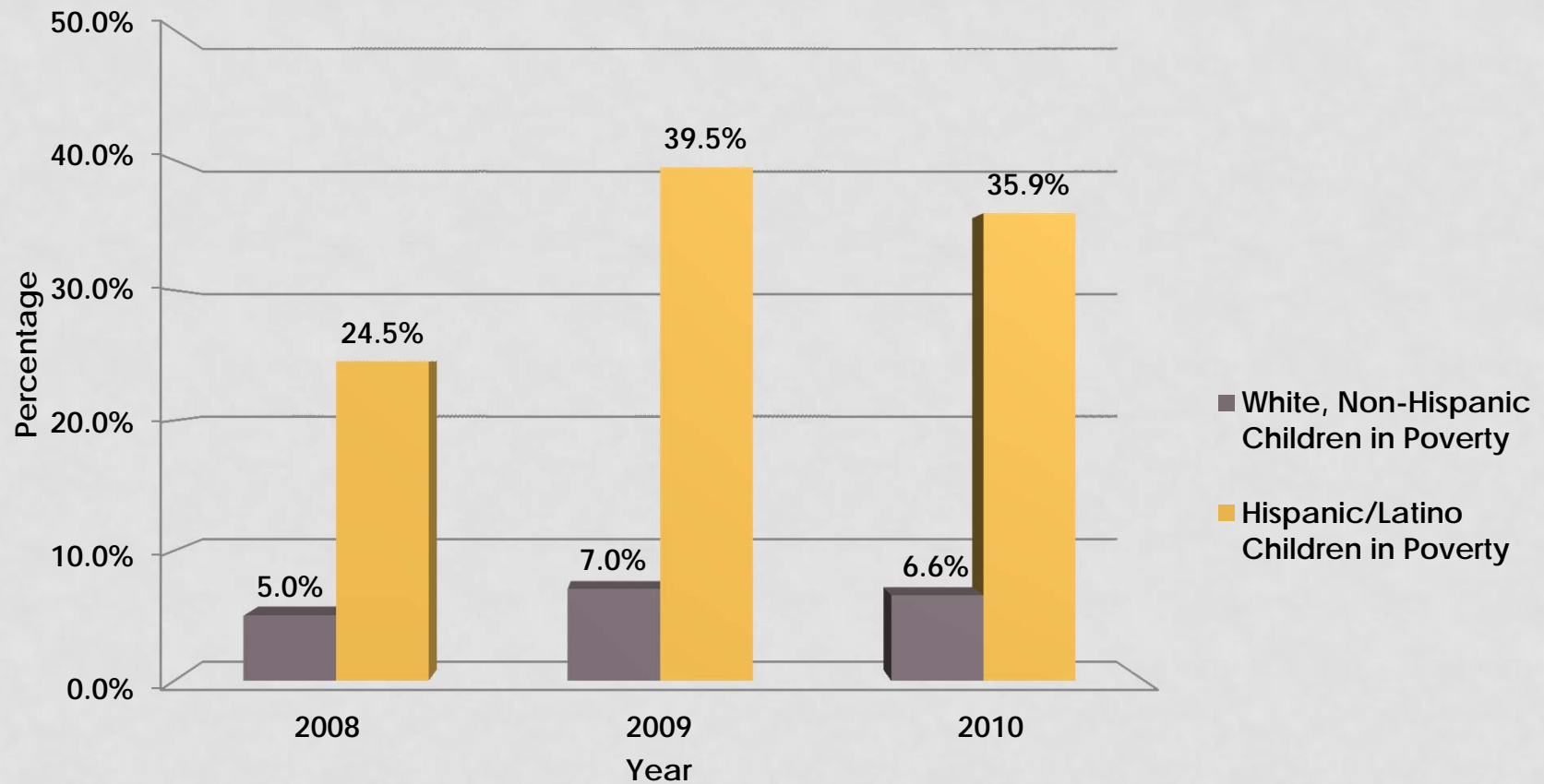
Percent of People in Poverty, 2005-09



POVERTY BY RACE

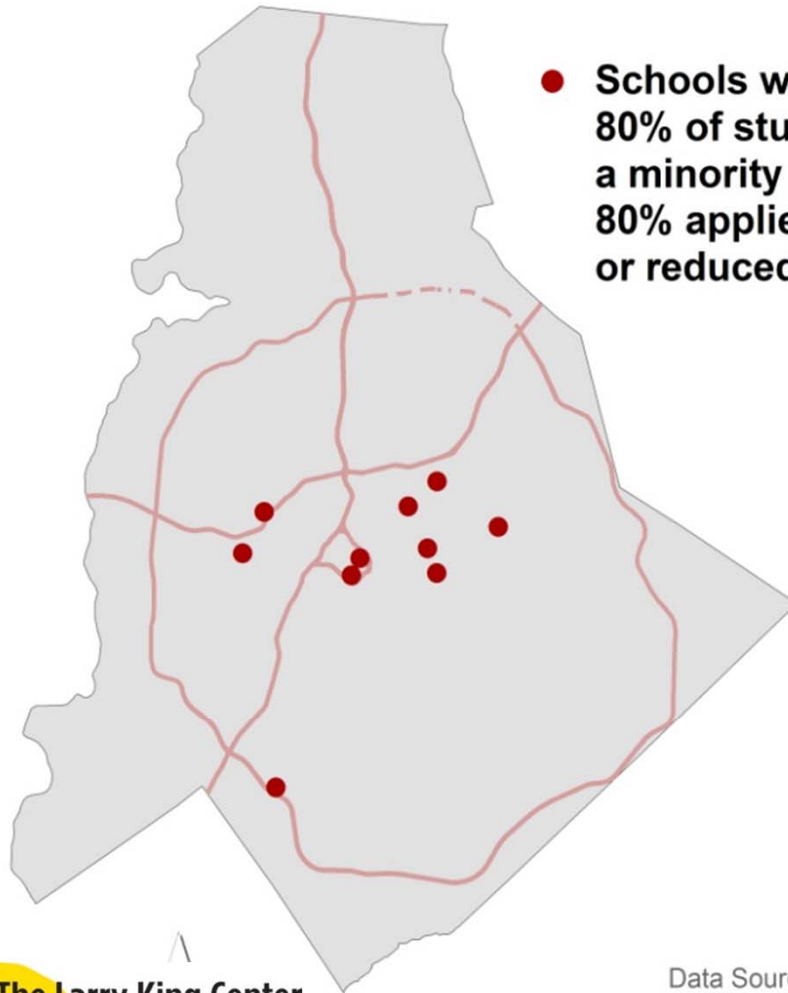


POVERTY BY ETHNICITY

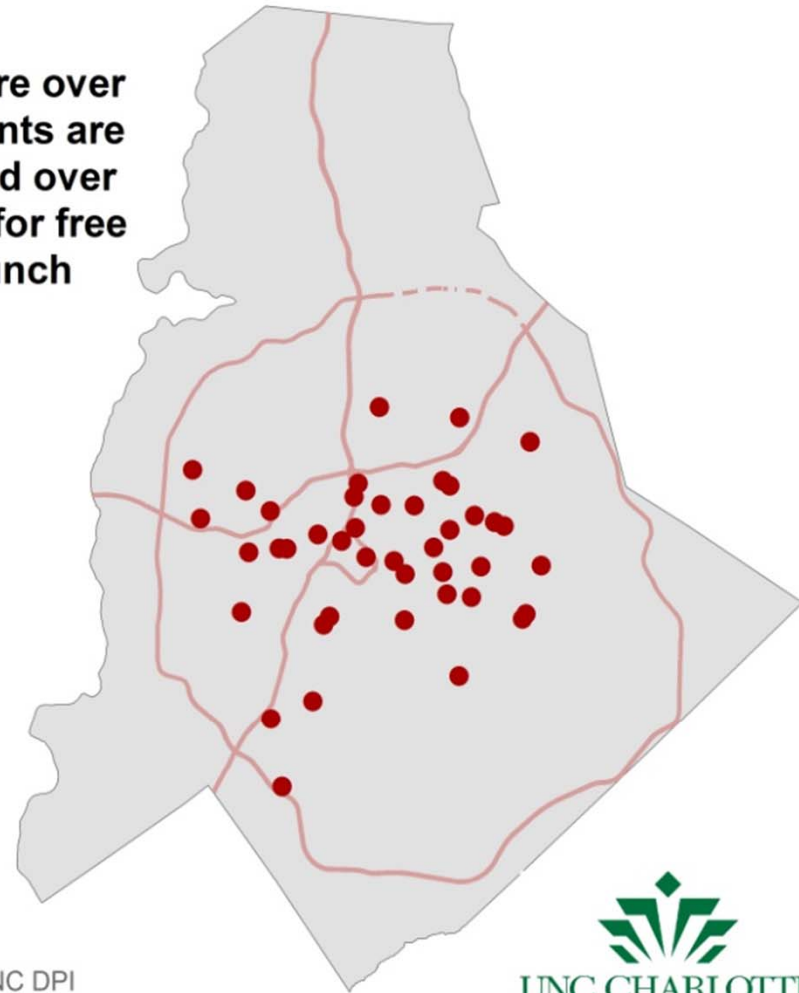


High-Poverty, High-Minority Schools in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools (CMS)

2001-02 School Year



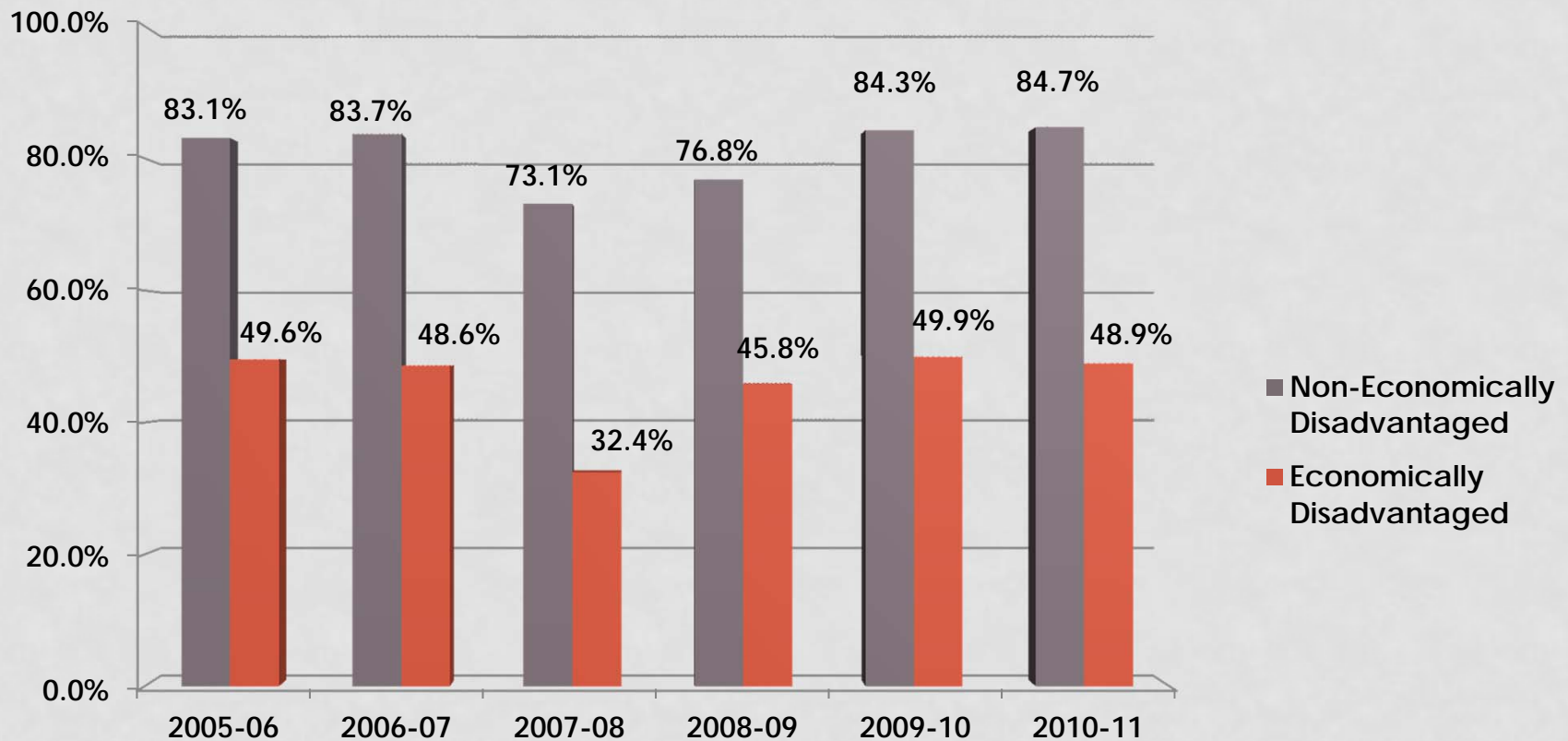
2008-09 School Year

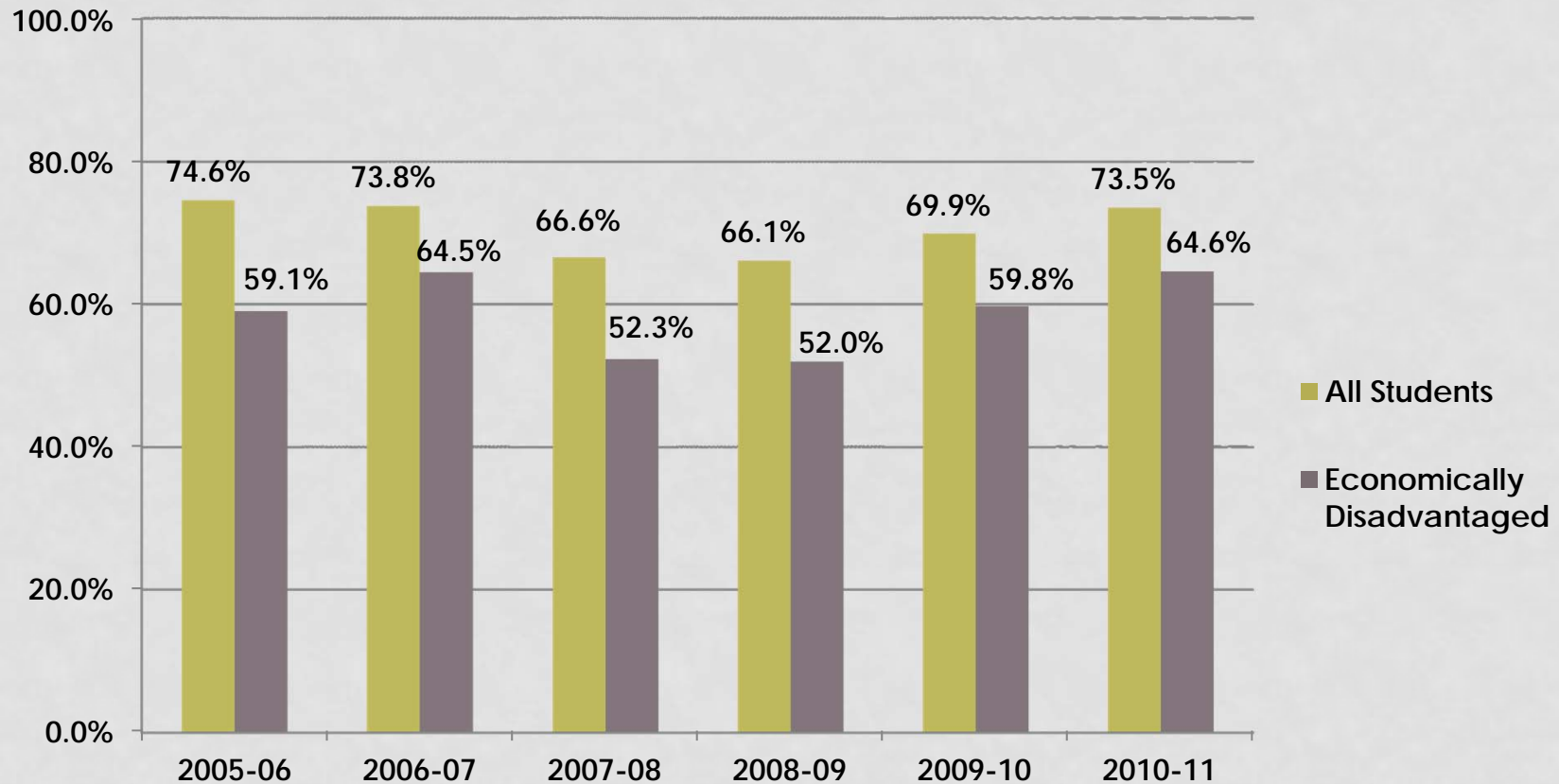

3RD GRADE READING AND MATH



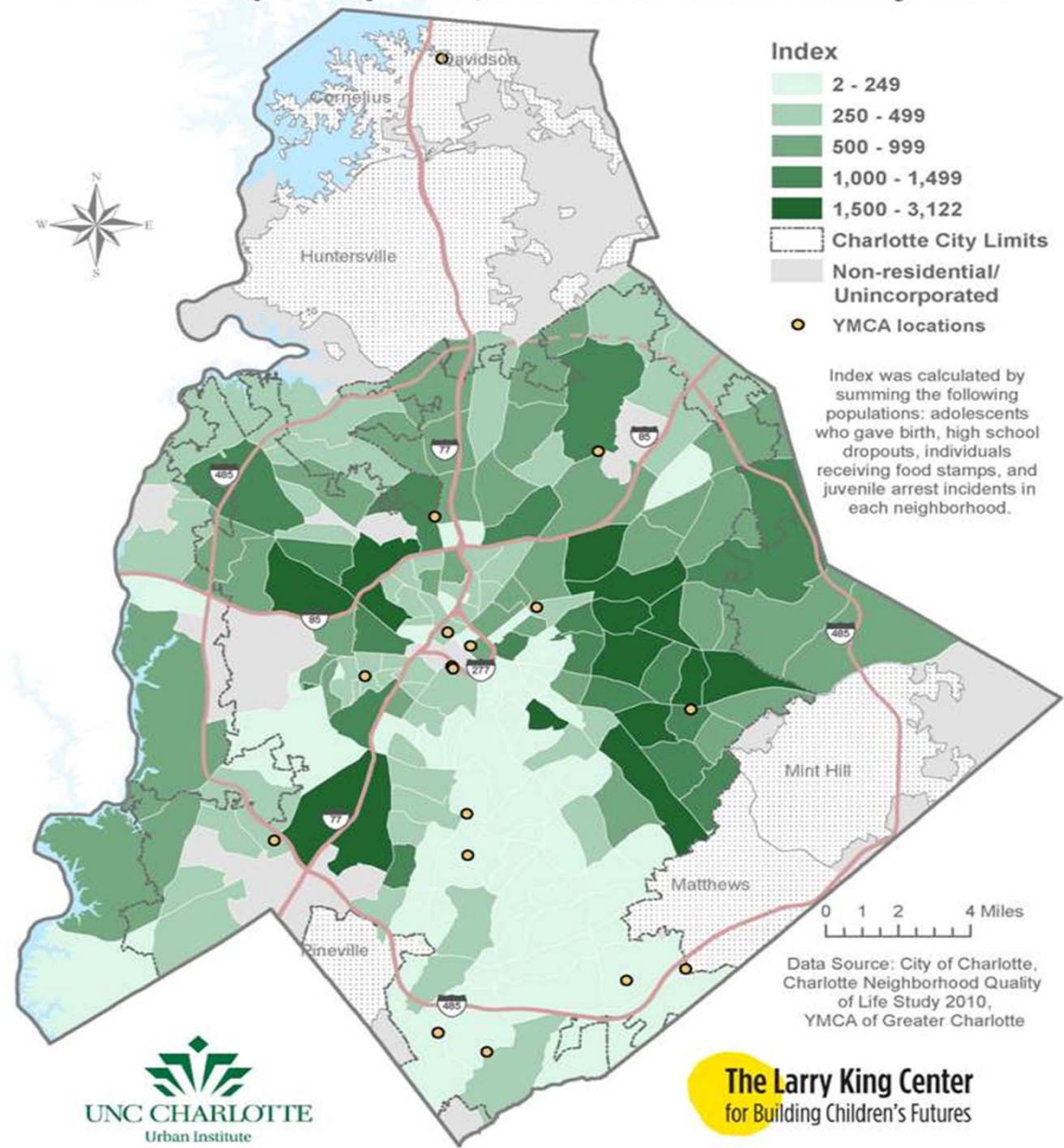

4-YEAR COHORT GRADUATION RATE

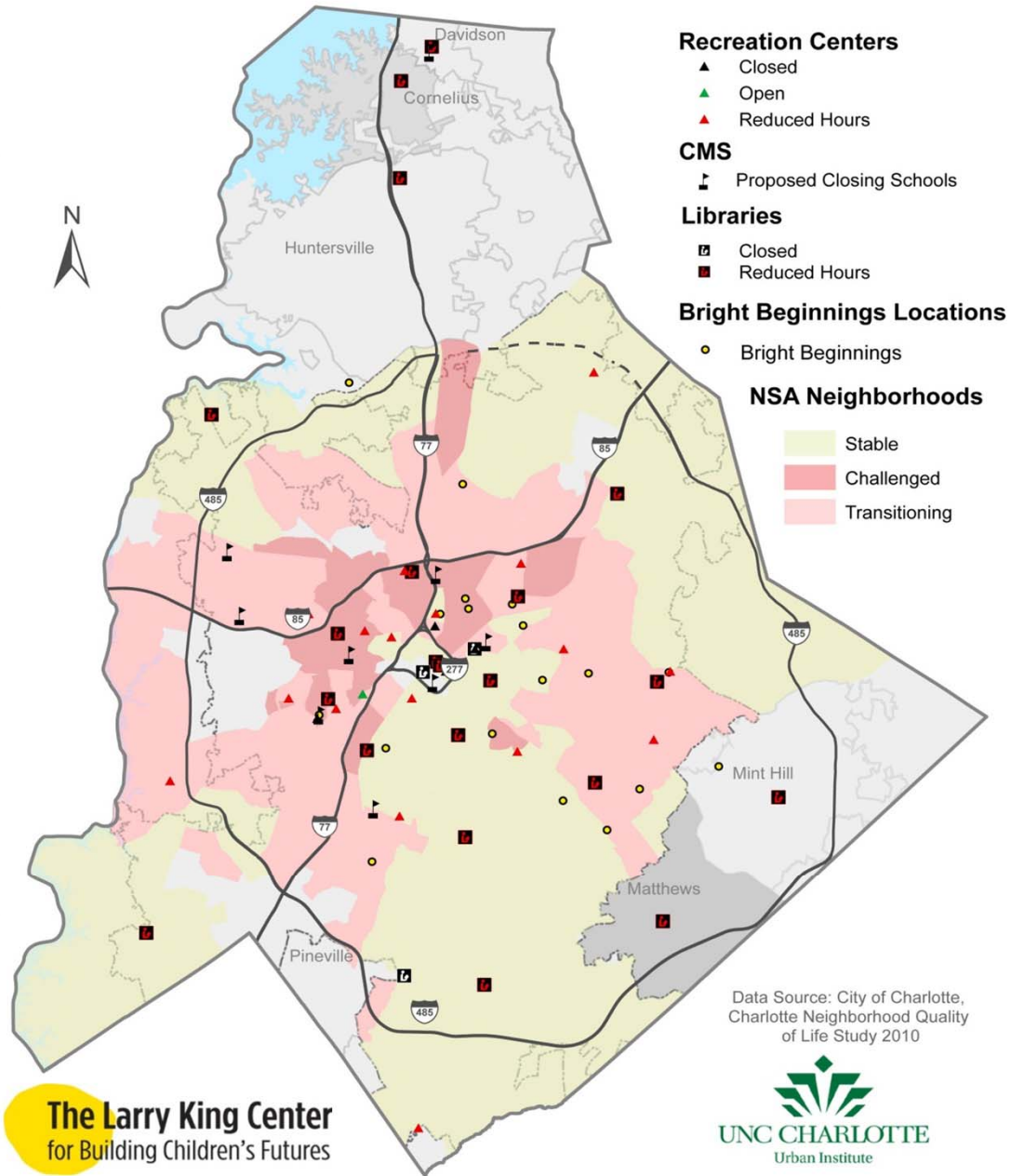
