


Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 10 to 14 by Race Mecklenburg County Residents 1995 through 2008






Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 15 to 17 by Race Mecklenburg County Residents 1995 through 2008




Annual Pregnancy Rates per 1,000 Females Age 18 to 19 by Race Mecklenburg County Residents 1995 through 2008


