# **2. Prioritization 2.0 Bicycle/Pedestrian Project Ranking** (Blackburn/McLamb) Description:

Each MPO/RPO and Division Office in the state will have the option to rank its top 5 bicycle and top 5 pedestrian projects in the prioritization database during the months of October - November. A subcommittee of the TCC has been formed to rank MUMPO's bicycle and pedestrian projects, but information will be required from project sponsors in order for the subcommittee to finish the ranking process. The subcommittee chair will provide information about what is required, as well as a timeline for the process.

### **3. Prioritization 2.0 CMAQ Process** (Polimeni)

### Description:

The NCDOT Transportation Planning Branch has recently released information about the P2.0 CMAQ process. A new application has been developed, which is required to be completed for all CMAQ candidate projects, and submitted to NCDOT in October 2011. MUMPO has an existing ranked list of CMAQ projects, which will be reviewed, an estimate of available CMAQ funds will be presented, and there will be a discussion about next steps in the CMAQ process.
