- The CTP Map Summary Report would function as an executive summary that explains the CTP and how to use the maps that are adopted as part of the CTP.
- The Map Summary Report would accompany the MUMPO-adopted maps/schedule.
- The CTP Full (?) Report would be more detailed, a “living” Report, and would not accompany the adopted maps/schedule.
- The following represents a draft topical outline for the Map/Summary Report:
  1. Purpose(s) of the CTP and CTP Maps
    - a. Background and brief history of change from Thoroughfare Plan to CTP
  2. Assumptions and Intent for MUMPO’s CTP and CTP Maps
  3. Definitions/descriptions of the Maps (regional “generic”)
    - a. Description of the four maps and how to use them
    - b. Definitions of the categories used for each of the adopted maps
    - c. Sources for category designations (including description of how the database works)
  4. Implementation of the CTP (regional “generic”) or “how, and by whom, streets get built or modified”
    - a. Ordinances
    - b. Projects (Possible CIP projects)
    - c. Generic multi-modal problem statements/”identified problem”
      - i. Elements that should be included in a multi-modal problem statement
      - ii. Examples of “categories” of multi-modal problem statements
  5. Implementation (local “also generic”)
    - a. Ordinances
    - b. Projects
    - c. Generic multi-modal problem statements
  6. Description of Update Process
    - a. For the CTP and Summary Report
    - b. For the “living” CTP Report
    - c. How the CTP will be amended (additions, deletions, alignments, e.g.)
      - i. Defining “technical” decisions versus “policy” decisions
      - ii. Proposed process(es) for each
