Town of Wingate North Carolina Department of Transportation 2004 Call-For-Projects Highway 74 Streetscape Project, Phase II

The US Highway 74 Streetscape Project will be within the Town Limits of Wingate. Our prime objective is to physically connect the existing communities, housing developments and Wingate University to the retail areas of the town. The project will improve Wingate's Community appearance and assist in attracting quality residential and commercial development.

Landscaping will help filter street noise and pollution from businesses. Shade trees will provide a cooling effect to pedestrians walking along Highway 74 on the new sidewalks. The new sidewalks will be safer for the residents to walk rather than directly on Highway 74. New decorative lights will provide greater illumination. This in turn provides a safer environment for the residents. The project will be applied to both sides of the highway.

Phase I, which was approved for TEA-21 funding in 2002, is between Main Street and Camden Street (east, approximately .5 mile). Phase II will be between Main Street and Bivens Street (west, approximately .3 mile).
