He requested that LUESA provide a report that reflects monitoring results from years past in addition to presently. Heather Davis will follow up on this request and report back to the Commission.</p> <p>Riverkeeper David Merryman asked how often Duke Energy monitors surface water. Ms. Davis replied that she understands that Duke monitors surface water weekly and heavy metals are tested quarterly.</p> <p>Lakekeepers Report – Alice Battle reported</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NC Wildlife Resource Commission, the Mountain Island Lake Marine Commission and the Catawba Riverkeeper Foundation are coordinating a boating safety course on March 6, 2010 from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm at the Mt. Holly Citizens Center, 400 East Central Avenue. The course is free to all participants. • Riverkeeper David Merryman informed the Commission of a 4-year study conducted by EPA that tests lakes nationwide for PCB in fish. Five Large-Mouth Bass and Carp were collected from Lake Norman, Lake Wateree and Mountain Island Lake. The results indicated elevated PCB numbers. Base Operating Plan (continued)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lake Management Plan (Battle) – Duke Energy commented on the results from the survey that was distributed in January 2008 to property owners around Mountain Island Lake. Duke feels that there is not enough hard data to support this plan. They suggest that the survey be generated to others such as; visitors to the lake. Vice Chairman Battle will get additional surveys and hand them out at the access areas. Duke also suggested that the Commission include the Mecklenburg Parks and Rec Department and the surrounding jurisdictions in the process of the Lake Management Plan. Battle reviewed police reports for safety data. If damage to boat is less than \$2,000, it's not reported. Battle has met with Barry Gullet of CMUD and Ed Cross with Gastonia Utilities. They are in favor of any action that protects the water supply. They can support the limiting of boat size, but permits are out of their areas of interest. Barry will distribute the Plan to the Water Managers Group, which has representation from the water utilities managers in the Catawba basin. The Plan was distributed to the NW Park District Advisory Council and the Stewardship Advisory Council of Mecklenburg County Parks and Rec. They have “no comment” as there was no perceived direct or quantifiable impact to the resource or the recreational amenities of Mountain Island Lake area nature preserves. 	
Blue Fin Award	<p>Blue Fin Award - This award is presented to an individual or an organization that goes above and beyond to make Mountain Island Lake a cleaner and safer place for us all. This year, the 2009 Blue Fin Award was presented to Sgt Charles McCants with the Gaston County Police Department. Sgt McCants through his proactive command and directives has had a positive impact on Mountain Island Lake. He identified a language barrier within the Hispanic community and resolved this by translating the No Trespassing brochures into Spanish. He also proactively addressed parking problems at Riverbend Access.
