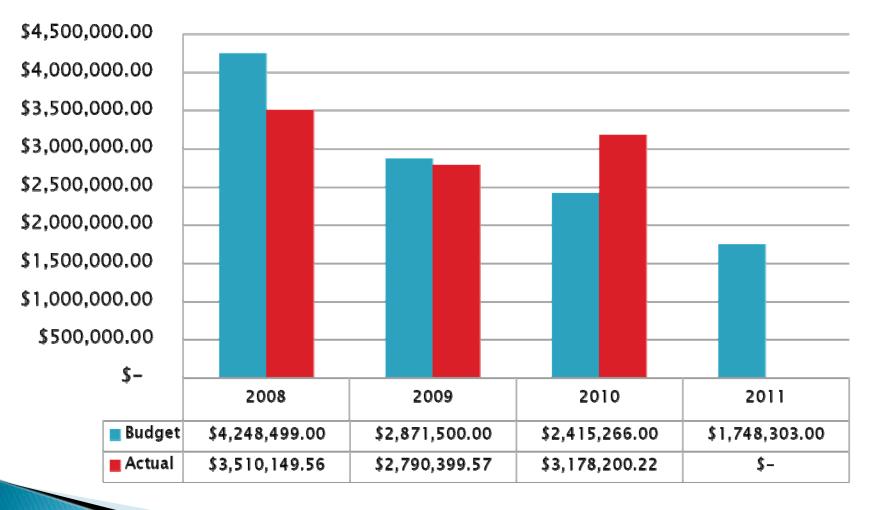

Note: Cumulative decrease in budgeted operating revenues of 58.8%



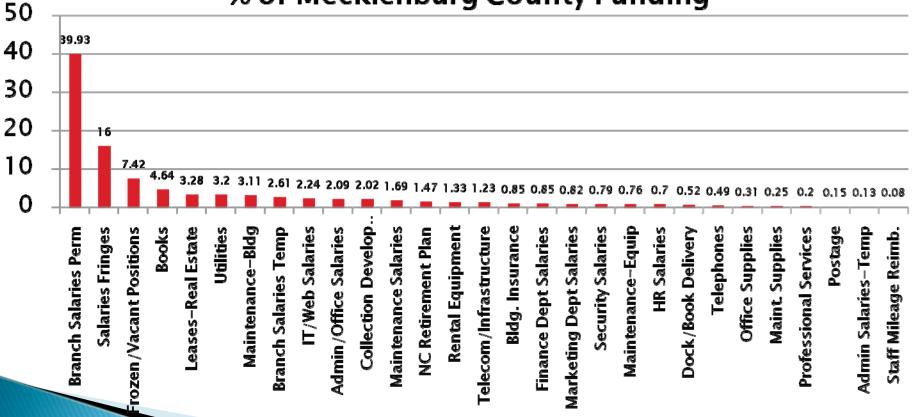

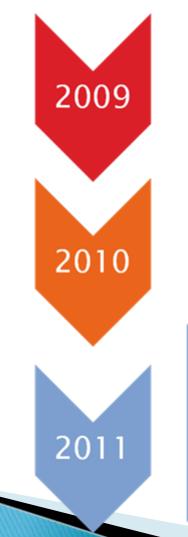
2010 Operational Expenses

% of Mecklenburg County Funding





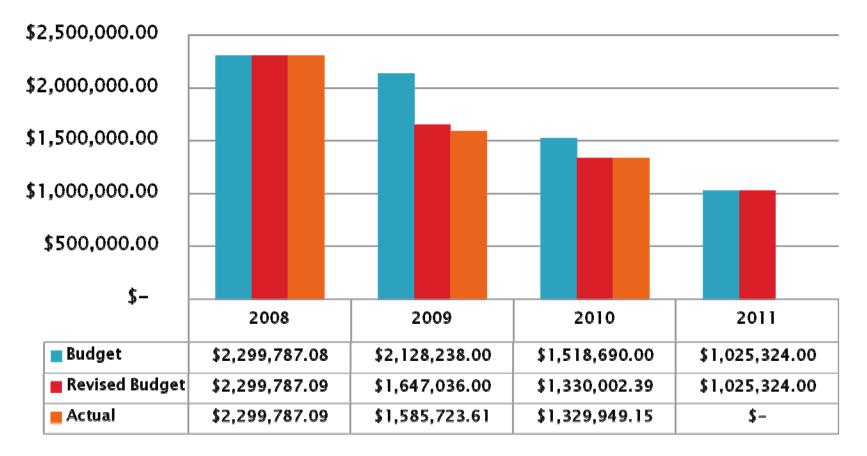
How Library Responded to Budget Cuts



- Closed Open Positions
- Eliminated 401k Match
- Cut county funded book budgets 31%
- Cut library funded book budgets 46%
- Took 5%, 10%, 20% salary reductions
- Continued elimination of 401k match
- · Laid off 120 staff members (Frontline)
- Reduced Service Hours 39%
- Cut Program Offerings
- Consolidated Maintenance and Security with Mecklenburg County
- Cut county funded book budgets an additional 12%
- Cut library funded book budgets an additional 13%
- Laid off 68 staff members (Support and Frontline)
- Reduced hours an additional 17% to 56% decline in service hours
- Closed 4 Locations
- Cut Program Offerings



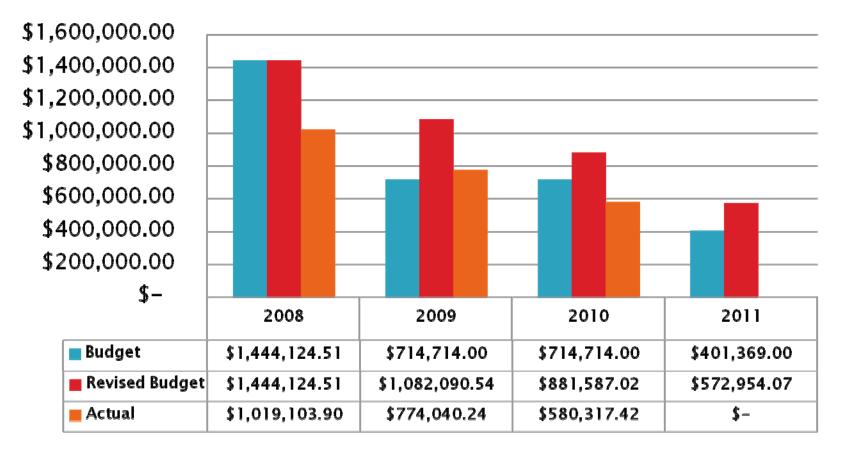
Book Budget County Funded

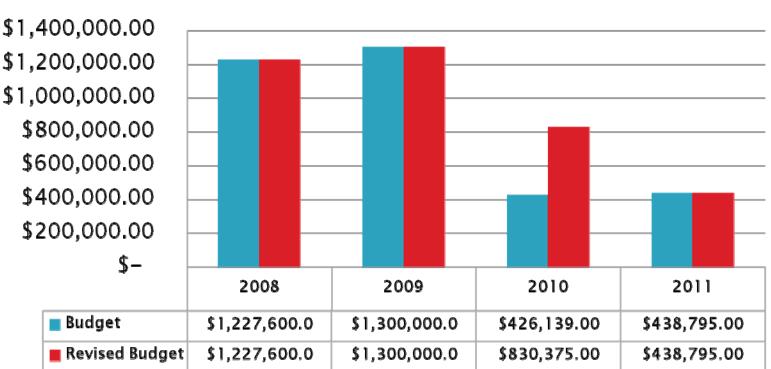

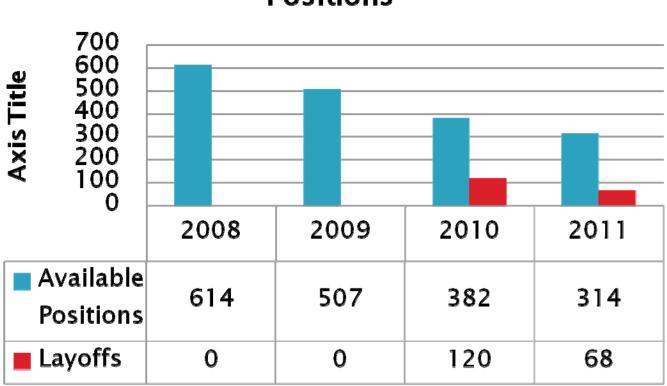
