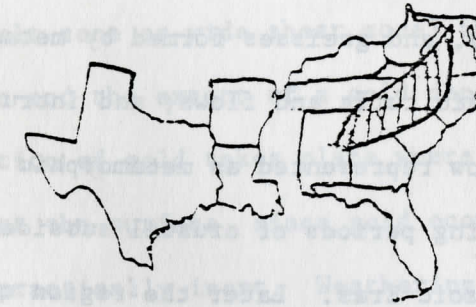


Figure 1. Approximate range of the southern Appalachian gold fields.

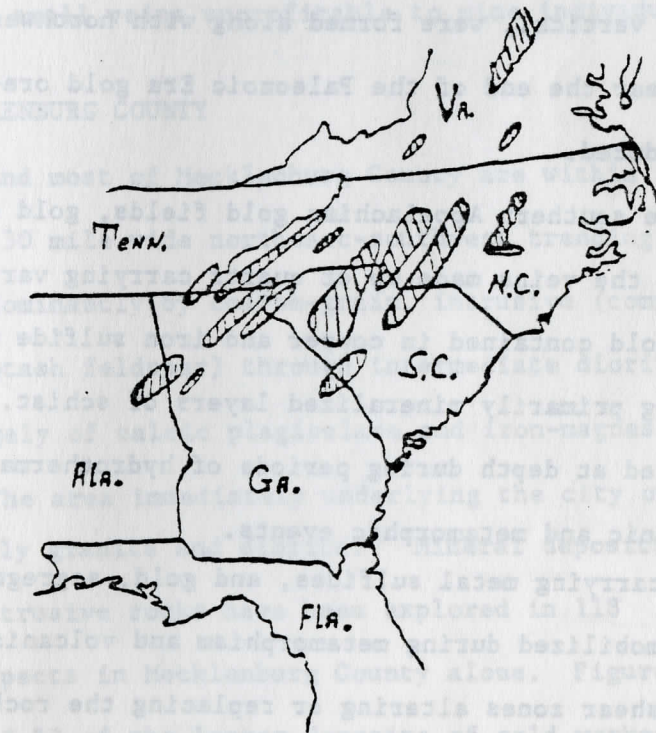


Figure 2. Mining districts comprising the southern Appalachian gold fields.
